

Choir Letter Criteria

To Letter in CHOIR you must receive a 1 or 2 at District or LSHS festival on a solo or ensemble, and complete at least 2 of the following Choir requirements

- Take Private Voice Lessons consistently from a person with a degree in music
- Be a Cast, Pit or Sound Crew member of the Musical
- Be a Member of Una Voce
- Be a Member of Titan Harmony
- Perform in the 9-10 Grade District Honor Choir
- Perform in the All-District Honor Choir (10-12)
- Perform in the District Women's Honor Choir
- Perform in the MCDA Summer Honor Choir (Previous Summer)
- Perform the National Anthem as a soloist at 3 LSW sponsored games (Concert Choir only)
- Participate in a church or community choir that meets regularly (Signature required)
- Complete 2 hours of Student Help at MSHSSA Solo/Ensemble or Large Ensemble Festival (Signature Required)
- Perform in 2 events for solo/ensemble (either District Festival or LSHS Festival)
- Other _____

To Letter with Distinction you must have lettered in choir and have a total of at least 4 Choir OR at least 4 Choir + Music Dept. requirements

- Take Private Lessons on any instrument from a person with a degree in music.
- Be a member of the Missouri All-State Choir
- Qualify and participate in the MCDA Sight-reading Bee
- Accompany a vocal soloist or vocal small ensemble at District Contest
- Be in a performing class from 2 of the following (Band, Choir, Orchestra)
- Perform with a SWACDA Honor Choir
- Assist and elementary music teacher consistently for the school year
- Attend a summer Music Camp (previous summer)

To Letter with Honors:

Cum Laude:

- 1) earn a choir letter
- 2) earn a 1 Rating at MSHSAA District Solo/Ensemble Festival

Magna Cum Laude:

- 1) earn a choir letter
- 2) are a member of the of the KC Metro Women's Honor Choir OR All-District Choir
- 3) earn a 1 Rating at MSHSAA District Solo/Ensemble Festival

Summa Cum Laude:

- 1) earn a choir letter
- 2) are a member of the of the All-State Choir
- 3) earn a 1 Rating at MSHSAA State Solo/Ensemble Festival?
