IF your absence has been approved by Mrs. Krinke, please complete the following:

Write an essay over a classical composer of your choice. Please use the following criteria:

- 1). Be at least 3 full pages typed. (one sided, double spaced, ½ inch margins, 12 pt font)
- 2). <u>Include a bibliography</u> (see examples below) of at least 3 resources. 1 of the 3 must NOT be an internet resource.
- 3). Demonstrate a growth of knowledge rather than a repetition of facts.
- 4). Contain and introduction, body, and conclusion.
- 5). Be neat legible and organized.

The essay must contain the following information (this is a starting point for you, but you will need to go into much more detail about the life of the composer)

- Circumstances regarding the birth, family, and death of the composer
- Other composers or circumstances that inspired him/her to compose
- Famous works/compositions written by this person
- How this composer impacted music history
